

About these Release Notes

The Veeva OpenData Europe Release Notes describe the features, updates, data impacts and customer benefits included in this Veeva OpenData Europe Major Release 22R3 Product Update. Veeva OpenData Europe refers to 49 European and Middle Eastern countries. These release notes will identify whether an enhancement applies to multiple countries or a specific country.

Multi-Country Enhancements

Country expansion: Middle East

Enhancement Overview

Veeva OpenData is expanding its footprint into new markets. With this release, we are happy to announce that 9 new markets in the Middle Eastern region will be covered by OpenData Europe, i.e.,

- Bahrain
- Egypt
- Jordan
- Kuwait
- Lebanon*
- Oman
- Qatar
- Saudi Arabia**
- United Arab Emirates

These new countries will include HCP records, such as physicians, and HCO records, such as hospitals, pharmacies, clinics, etc.

Please note:

- *) Lebanon will only be commercially available in Q1, 2023
- **) The availability of the Saudi Arabia database is subject to change due to current legal developments in the applicable law.

For 2023, we are planning to expand even further. So, stay tuned for our next release.

Benefits

To support large global teams of our customers, OpenData targets to be available in all the markets where our customers are operating. In direct response to that customer need, we are expanding our OpenData footprint into these 9 new markets. Sales and marketing teams will be able to accelerate commercial activities within these countries.



Public Claims Data

Enhancement Overview

In this release, Public Claims Data has expanded in coverage and added **Poland, Hungary, Czech Republic and Slovakia** to our existing EU5 Public Claims Data offering. Additionally, if our customers already have access to our OpenData product you will get **HCO mapping** information between Public Claims Data and OpenData for **EU5 and the Netherlands** with this release.

You can get access to the datasets part of this product as part of our Public Claims Data ELA (Enterprise License Agreement) for one or more countries in Europe. Our ELA for Public Claims Data includes:

- Access to unlimited claims data reports for selected countries
- Access to specific diagnoses (e.g. ICD-10) and procedures (e.g. OPCS-4)
- Match to Veeva OpenData ID (VID) for all claims relevant HCOs
- Delivery as per customer requirements and format (xls, csv, etc.)

Benefits

These datasets help you to dynamically fulfill your commercial targeting business needs. Public Claims Data allows you to identify HCOs, and with the link to our OpenData the corresponding HCPs, which have high concentrations of cases for a particular disease. This will allow you to identify best opportunities to collaborate with the HCOs/HCPs for clinical drug trials specially for rare diseases.

Public claims data also enables micro-targeting for sales and marketing activities by combining diagnosis, procedures, and prescription for a disease with its geographical footprint. Additionally, it provides insights on share of prescription drugs directly at prescribing HCO level which will enable you to identify target HCOs for your Go-to-Market strategy.

HCP Email data expansion

Enhancement Overview

With 21R3, we launched Emails for physicians in EU5. In line with our commitment to provide HCP emails for all of Europe, we are happy to announce that in 22R3 verified Emails are now available for 6 additional key countries: Belgium, Bulgaria, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Portugal, Turkey.

As per our approach, the new HCP Emails will be part of the core HCP profile at no additional cost for our customers with an Enterprise License Agreement. We will continue to constantly increase the scope and coverage over the next releases. So watch out for further updates.

Country Specific Enhancements

Germany

Enhancement Overview

Germany focused on two major updates in this release.

- The German team did an extensive review of the whole German database to identify
 owners of practices and pharmacies, identifying >35.000 owners across all HCP types. The
 updated information is reflected in the HCP's relation type. This update helps our
 customers to identify and easily engage with their most relevant stakeholders.
- Second update was the review of our pharmacists universe with focus on increasing our counts of pharmacy technicians (to >4.000) and business assistants (to >1.000). The update covers retail and hospital pharmacies.

Technical Details

Pharmacy owners:

 Respective population can be identified via relationship type "Ownership (EN) / Inhaber (DE)" to parent HCO (pharmacy).

Pharmacy technicians/business assistants:

- Both HCPs are grouped into HCP type "Non-Prescribing Health Care Professional (EN) / Nicht verschreibender HCP (DE)", and can be identified:
- (1) for pharmacy technicians with
 - professional title "Pharmacy Technician (EN) / Pharmazeutisch technischer Assistent /-in (DE)" and
 - relationship type "Pharmacy Technician (EN) / Pharmazeutisch-technische/-r Assistent/-in (DE)"
- (2) for business technicians with
 - professional title "Other Health Professionals (EN) /Andere/r
 Gesundheitsexpert/-in (DE)" and
 - relationship type "Dispenser / Medicines Counter Assistant (EN)
 /Pharmazeutisch-kaufmännische/-r Assistent/-in (DE)"

Benefits

The addition of pharmacy owners helps our customers to identify relevant clusters and find out the most relevant contact persons for their sales teams. Expanding our pharmacy universe with HCP types, such as pharmacy technician & business assistants helps our customers to identify highly customer-facing profiles, easily.



France

Enhancement Overview

In France, the major focus around the medical residency in 3 main aspects:

- 1. Validating all GPs in primary care practices having an "internship supervisor" grade. Those GPs play a role in the medical studies path as they host students every 6 months in their cabinets and also teach in universities.
- 2. Proactively including the new yearly residents batch with 8.000 new students: those are available with their right specialty, affiliation, RPPS Id and university of residency.
- 3. Set-up better automated processes to qualify recently graduated junior doctors with their right types, hospital grades, affiliations, RPPS Id and their studies path.

Technical Details

A new HCP's grade 'MSU' has been introduced in the French data model to clearly identify the GPs having that specific accreditation

Benefits

Residents are key and relevant stakeholders for our customers' sales teams and must be easily actionable.

Spain

Enhancement Overview

In Spain, there were two main focus areas for this release:

- 1. Increase the number of tax ID across all HCOs but specifically for pharmacies.
- 2. Proactively including the new yearly residents batch with 10.000 new residents across all specialties.

Technical Details

- 1. Tax IDs are identifiable in the data model with the tax id v field.
- 2. All residents are being mapped with hcp_type__v = R for a simple search and reporting.

Benefits

Having more and more HCOs with Tax ID is helping healthcare companies to better identify potential HCOs that are key to their business. In addition, this value is helping for a better data integration between the different downstream systems.

On the other hand, residents are key and relevant stakeholders for our customers' sales teams and must be easily actionable.



United Kingdom and the Republic of Ireland

Enhancement Overview

In the UK and the Republic of Ireland the Specialty and Focus Area reference value management process for Pharmacists and Pharmacy Technicians will be standardized. The only allowed Specialty Values will be Hospital Pharmacy, Retail Pharmacy, Medicine Management or Unspecified Specialty. Any other value (such as Oncology, Respiratory etc.) will from now one be managed as a Focus Area.

Technical Details

- Only allowed values for the Pharmacists and Pharmacy Technicians in the specialty_n_v
 fields will be: Hospital Pharmacy, Retail Pharmacy, Medicine Management or Unspecified
 Specialty
- All the current specialty values that don't follow the criteria above will be moved to the focus_area_n__v fields
- We will continue to collect and manage the areas of expertise for Pharmacists and Pharmacy Technicians in the focus_area_n_v fields (e.g. Pharmacists working in Oncology Pharmacy Team will have Focus Area = Oncology)

Benefits

Aligned Specialty and Focus Area values on Pharmacist and Pharmacy Technician populations.

Nordics

Enhancement Overview

In the Nordics, the team focused on four main updates for this release. In **Finland**, the team has proactively reviewed the changing hierarchical structure of the Finnish Healthcare system. In **Denmark**, our focus was on increasing the Specialist Nurse population with a focus on Anesthesiology Nurses. We were able to add 1.400+ nurses with that review. The Danish database has also been extended to now cover the whole healthcare systems of both **Faroe Islands** and **Greenland**. In Iceland, the Nutrition and Food Science population has been added for general availability.

Technical Details

- In Finland the counties will be at the top HCO level in any hierarchy from the public sector
- In Denmark removed the process that made it impossible to save a Danish record with a different address country (Faroe, Greenland) than Denmark



Benefits

Speed is a key value to OpenData and we were able to follow the changes in the Finnish healthcare system quickly, providing our customers with fresh and correct information for the easier identification of HCOs. Specialist nurses and experts related to nutrition are becoming increasingly more important stakeholders for our customers and thus must be available.

Baltics

Enhancement Overview

In the Baltics, our newly launched countries from the summer release (R2/2022), the team focused on achieving a full coverage of our core population data, such as key HCOs and all medical doctors.

Technical Details

Made existing status_reason fields available for Baltics

Benefits

Reaching full coverage of core populations is essential for our customers to easily find their targets.

Central Eastern Europe

Enhancement Overview

We happily announced that the Market access flag has been introduced in Hungary, Czech Republic and Slovakia in 22R2. Within this release the market access population has been expanded to,

- The pharmacy ecosystem
- Purchasing officers and financial managers

Additionally, the Hungarian team has added 2.000+ new pharmacy technicians to their database.

Technical Details
